Warwick – **A Singing Town** is now in its third year and is all set to continue well into the future.

In the autumn term 2023 we ran or supported:

16 events in **13** venues involving

400+ singers to an audience of 1,200+ local people

In addition we expanded our Singing for Health provision and are delighted to announce major new funding from The Charity of Thomas Oken and Nicholas Eyffler to enable further expansion of our Singing for Health programme – and this means even more opportunities for local people to benefit from singing.


